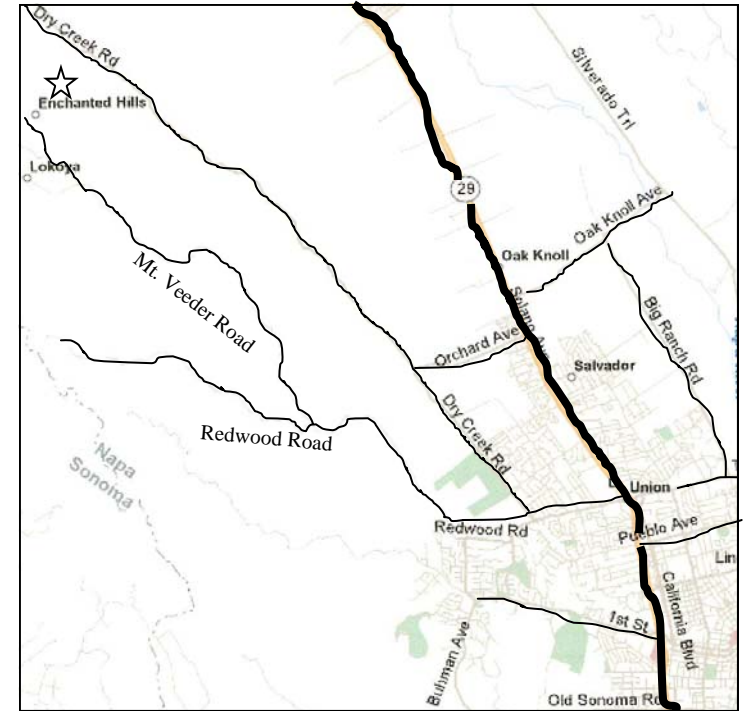

DIRECTIONS:

From San Francisco: Take 101 North across Golden Gate Bridge. Go 20 miles to 37 exit to Napa/Vallejo. At Sears Point, turn left (East) onto 121. At Big Bend, stay right on Hwys 121/12 to Napa. Turn left (North) at Hwy 29 to Napa. **Take Redwood Road exit.**

☆ **After taking the Redwood Road Exit off 29, turn left onto Redwood Road. At first fork of Redwood Road & Dry Creek Road, keep left, staying on Redwood. At second fork of Redwood and Mt. Veeder, keep right. You're now on Mt. Veeder Road. Go 6 miles (about 20 minutes) on Mt. Veeder Road. The camp driveway will be on your right.**

From East Bay: Travel East on 1-80 beyond Carquinez Bridge to Vallejo. (From East Contra Costa, take 1-680 to ☆ 1-780 in Benicia, then continue East on 1-80). Take Hwy 37 exit to Napa. Take Hwy. 29 exit to Napa. Stay on Hwy 29 North. **Take Redwood Road exit. Follow directions above.**

From ☆ Sacramento: Take 1-80 West to Hwy 12 West just beyond Fairfield. At Hwy 29, turn right going North to Napa. **Take Redwood Road exit. Follow directions above.**

From Northern Napa County: Take Hwy 29 South toward Napa. At Oakville, turn right onto Oakville Grade. Continue to the right at the intersection of Oakville Grade and Dry Creek Road. Turn left onto Mt. Veeder Road. Go approx. 2 miles to camp driveway on your left.

From Santa Rosa: Take Hwy 12 East past Kenwood. Turn left on Trinity Road. Trinity Road becomes Dry Creek Road. Turn right onto Mt. Veeder Road. Go 2 approx. 2 miles to camp driveway.

From Sonoma Area: Take ☆ Hwy 12 East. Turn left onto 121/12 to Napa. Hwy 121/12 will run into Hwy 29. Turn left onto Hwy 29 North to Napa. **Take Redwood Road exit. Follow directions above.**
